

The order:

Chlamydia	Pain when urinating, unusual discharge, women – tummy pain, bleeding after sex and between periods, in men – pain and swelling in testicles
Human Papillomavirus	No symptoms, may not know if have the it or not
Gonorrhoea	Thick green or yellow discharge from vagina or penis, pain when urinating, in women – bleeding between periods
Syphilis	Small painless sores or ulcers, blotchy red rash, small skin growths, white patches in mouth, tiredness, headaches, joint pains, fever and swollen glands
Genital Herpes	Small blisters, open sores around genitals, anus, thighs or bottom, tingling, burning or itching around genitals, pain when urinating, in women – vaginal discharge
HIV / AIDS	Flu-like illness 2-6 weeks after infection which lasts 1-2 weeks once these symptoms disappear may not cause any more symptoms for years although it will continue to damage your
