Category 1	Conditions where premature death is inevitable	Batten disease, mucopolysaccharidosis
Category 2	Progressive condition without curative treatment	Cancer, irreversible organ failures of heart, liver or kidney
Category 3	Irreversible but non-progressive condition causing severe disability, leading to susceptibility to health complications	Cystic fibrosis, Duchenne muscular dystrophy
Category 4	Life threatening condition for which curative treatment bay be possible but may fail	Severe cerebral palsy, multiple disabilities – following brain or spinal cord injury
