Fistula		Abnormal connection between two hollow spaces
Cellulitis		Bacterial skin infection
Bacteraemia		Presence of bacteria in the blood
Hyponatraemia		Low sodium levels in blood
Chorda		Tendon
Dysplasia		Abnormal cells or growth in tissue
Stent		Tiny tube inserted into blocked passageway to keep it open
Hernia		Internal body part pushes through tissue or muscle wall
Dyspnoea		Difficult or laboured breathing
Hypoxia		Lack of oxygen supply to tissues
Anaerobic respiration		Breathing that does not produce oxygen
Lactic acid		Produced when body breaks down carbohydrates for energy
Ischaemia		Restriction in blood supply to tissues
Bronchoconstriction		Narrowing of the air passages
Synapse		Junction between two nerve cells
