Loss of pregnancy before 20 weeks' gestation
Intra-uterine infection
High blood pressure occurring in second half of pregnancy
Babies born before at 37 weeks or before
Deficiency of iron during pregnancy when body needs more
Lack of insulin during pregnancy
Sudden spike in blood pressure during pregnancy
Loss of pregnancy after the 20 <sup>th</sup> week of pregnancy
Result of embryo implantation outside of the uterus, typically in Fallopian tube
Pregnant woman having seizures or fits likely to result in coma or death
Autoimmune disorder in which body develops antibodies which attacks its own cells and tissues
Severe and persistent nausea and vomiting throughout pregnancy
Low-lying placenta which may cause problems with delivery or baby's support system
Slow or halted growth of fetus
Placenta detaches from uterine wall affecting baby's support
