

Answers:

1. Order by type of FGM is below:

Type 1	Known as clitoridectomy, consists of partial or total removal of the clitoris and / or its prepuce.
Type 2	Known as excision, the clitoris and labia minora are partially or totally removed with or without excision of the labia majora.
Type 3	Most severe, known as infibulation or pharaonic type. Procedure consists of narrowing the vaginal orifice with creation of a covering seal by cutting and appositioning the labia minora and /or labia majora, with or without removal or clitoris.
Type 4	Consists of all other harmful procedures to female genitalia for non-medical purposes. Such as pricking, piercing, incising, scraping or cauterization.
